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INSTALL

- 1 Align your boats parallel. Find a flat part of the hull near the back to place your first HookCup.
- 2 Place the end that is labeled #1 on your first boat. Apply strong pressure to the cups and push down levers to lock in place.
- 3 Firmly press the cups of the end labeled #2 on the second boat and lock in place. Your first HookCup has now connected both boats!
- 4 Place your second HookCup near the midpoint of the boats, or about 10ft (3m) from the first HookCup. Ensure that the end labeled #1 is on boat 1 and end #2 is on boat 2 to match your first HookCup.

Ideal Placement



CONNECT YOUR BOAT & FLOAT



TIP! Use a third HookCup for boats longer than 30ft (9m). Do not place cups on decals or boat stickers.

UNINSTALL: Lift the levers up on all cups to disconnect. Before putting away, ensure your HookCups™ are clean and dry with the cups folded inward.

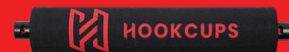

ASSEMBLE

BAR ×2



PIN ×4



#1 CIRCLE CONNECTOR ×2



#2 OVAL CONNECTOR ×2



Insert one end of the bar into a **#1 circle** connector, and the other end of the bar into a **#2 oval** connector, making sure to align the pin holes.



Make sure **each** HookCup has an end labeled #1, and an end labeled #2.

Insert the pin through the bar and connector, and wrap the metal loop around the connector, latching over the bottom of the pin.
